Code of conduct for committee members

At Verwood Town Football Club we want football to be safe and fun for all age groups. The club ethos explains the guiding principles of the club. As committee members we expect you to:

- Uphold the club ethos at all times
- Encourage and promote best practice in the wider club
- Support and sustain the professional image of the club in the community and with the FA by your actions
- Attend and support planned committee meetings, and where unable to attend contribute a written report to the chairman and secretary
- Dedicate time to undertake committee duties as they relate to your role, being aware of any legal responsibilities you have to the club
- Ask for help if you are struggling with duties
- Support committee decisions and address any areas of concern with discretion

By not following the code of conduct then any or all of the following action may be taken:

- A meeting with experienced committee members to explore any support needed with the role or to determine if you have the time to devote to it
- Asked to leave the committee
- Serious concerns will follow the club disciplinary policy and may need to be reported to county FA.
